School Day	- The school hours will be similar to last year. The start & end of the school day will be planned based on dropoff & dismissal procedures. - Students will follow their school schedule on both in-person and remote days. On remote days, this will be done through Google Meet.	- The school hours will be similar to last year. The start & end of the school day will be planned based on dropoff & dismissal procedures - Students will follow their school schedule through Google Meet.
Attendance Format	Students attend school 2 days a week in-person & 3 days a week remotely.	Students attend school remotely 5 days a week.
Placement	Students will be placed in classes with TPS teachers and will have those same teachers on both in-person and remote days. Students will be “in class” with their peers five days a week.	In most cases, students will be placed in classes with TPS teachers and will be “in class” with their peers five days a week. On a rare occasion, a student may be placed in a class or classes that are provided by one of our online learning partners. (e.g. AP course at THS & TPS teacher is unavailable)
Student Attendance	On in-person days, attendance will be taken according to regular practices. On remote days, attendance will be determined based on the student being “in class” (on camera) as well submission of assignments/assessments and participation in virtual sessions.	Attendance will be determined based on the student being “in class” (on camera) as well submission of assignments/assessments and participation in virtual sessions.
Participation Work Completion Grades	- Students are expected to participate in class at the level determined by each teacher on both in-person and remote days. - Students are expected to complete assignments and assessments to the best of their abilities and will be graded accordingly by each teacher on both in-person and remote days.	- Students are expected to participate “in class” at the level determined by each teacher. - Students are expected to complete assignments and assessments to the best of their abilities and will be graded accordingly by each teacher.
