## **Historical Investigation Peer Review Rubric**

Part A: Framing the Issue
Research question that is specific to a particular revolution
Plan of investigation (sources that will be used)
One full paragraph
Part B: Summary of Evidence
At least four sources are used (one has to be a print source)
The sources are weaved together, into a "story" of the research
Organized by time (chronologically) or by topic (thematically) – NOT a list of sources in order
MLA citation guide for "in-text" citations is followed
2 FULL (not one and 2/3rds) to 3 pages
Part C: Analysis
Commentary about the evidence in Part B, as related to the research question
One page or more
Part D: Conclusion
Thesis statement that is an answer to the research question and explanation of importance
One full paragraph
Part E: Bibliography
The start of each citation is indented, like to start a paragraph
Single spaced within citations, double spaced after each citation
MLA format for "works cited" citations, in alphabetical order
ALL OF THE ABOVE:
Times New Roman, Size 12 Font
Double spaced (except within citations in Part E)
No use of first/second person ("I" or "my" or "you" for instance), except in Part A
