Bring Your Own MacBook (Specifications)

Dear Parents of Grade 5 to 12 students,

Grades 5 and up have a 'bring your own MacBook' policy at HJIS. We recognize the need for students to use mobile devices to support teaching and learning; and for students to utilize their own technology in a more seamless way in the classroom. The use of technology to support learning in education is an area we at HJIS believe enhances and supports learning, thinking, creativity, communication and collaboration across learning experiences.

Our Grade 5 to 12 students are expected to bring their Macbooks to school everyday.

As we encourage our students to use their MacBooks extensively as collaboration tools, we have minimum recommendations for your child's device. An excessively slow device may hinder the student's ability to work in a timely manner and take part in more advanced parts of certain projects. These devices will be used throughout secondary school and secondary teachers have raised concerns that some of the MacBooks older than 4 years have had numerous issues running required programs. The below recommendations will ensure the MacBook purchased could be used beyond Grade 5.
