Placement Letter Google Form - Due Today!



Stomach Illness Reminder

- 1. Please remind your children that frequent handwashing with soap and water, especially after using the bathroom and before eating, is the best way to prevent yourself from getting sick.
- 2. Hand sanitizer does not kill the "germs" that are responsible for making you sick with a stomach illness.

 Handwashing is going to be your number one defense!
- 3. Teachers/Staff have been instructed to frequently wipe down high touch surfaces to help limit spread.
- 4. Your child should stay home from school for at least 24 hours after their last vomiting episode and or 24 hours fever free without fever reducing medications.



Take Note! Valid Cori forms Required to Volunteer

Please take note that you must have a <u>valid Cori on</u> <u>file</u> to volunteer at Wheelock School. Wheelock offers many wonderful opportunities so don't miss out! If you are unsure if your Cori is valid please contact the office. All Cori's must be brought directly to the office so that we may take a copy of your license or passport (this must be done in person). We will then send it to Human Resources for processing.

Please allow one week of processing time.

Cori forms are valid for three years across all Medfield public schools.



<u>Update from Nurse Keigan</u> 4/16/25

Please continue to be mindful of keeping your child home if they are not feeling well.

With the onset of winter, there has been an increase in illnesses, such as colds, influenza, strep throat, pneumonia, respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), COVID, and stomach illeness (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea) throughout the state. In order to keep our school environment healthy and minimize the spread of viruses, please keep your child(ren) home from school if they are not feeling well and contact their health care provider if needed.

If your child tests positive for and/or has been diagnosed with COVID, influenza, strep throat, RSV, or pneumonia, please be sure to let us know in the school health office. In addition, please let us know if your child is home sick with a fever, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.

Your child may return to school when they feel well enough to be in school for full day days AND

- After being fever-free for 24 hours without any fever/pain-reducing medication;
- After they have resumed eating normally and have not had any recurrence of vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours if they have had a gastrointestinal virus (norovirus);
- After they have been on an antibiotic for 24 hours if they have tested positive for strep throat or another type of bacterial infection.
