AN ACT TO ESTABLISH FUNDING FOR SEX WEEK 2020

INTRODUCED BY: SENATOR CHANEL LEE AND ADDY PERLMAN AND CONSIDERED THE 10TH DAY OF MARCH IN THE YEAR 2020

THE COMMITTEE ON HEALTH, SAFETY, AND SUSTAINABILITY WHICH RECOMMENDS ITS PASSAGE/FAILURE BY A VOTE OF 9 TO 0 TO 0.

THE COMMITTEE ON FINANCE WHICH RECOMMENDS ITS PASSAGE/FAILURE BY A VOTE OF ${\bf 4}$ TO ${\bf 0}$.

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Student Government Association of The Johns Hopkins University assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE.


This Act may be referred to as the "Sex Week Funding Bill," or the "Sex Week Bill"

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

- (a) SGA The term "SGA" shall refer to the Student Government Association of The Johns Hopkins University.
- (b) JHU, Hopkins The terms "JHU" and "Hopkins" shall refer to The Johns Hopkins University.
- (c) OIE The term "OIE" shall refer to the Office of Institutional Equity of The Johns Hopkins University.
- (d) SARU The term "SARU" shall refer to the Sexual Assault Resource Unit, a student organization at The Johns Hopkins University.
- (e) LGBTQ Life The term "LGBTQ Life" shall refer to the office that serves the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, and allied community at The Johns Hopkins University.
- (f) CHEW The term "CHEW" shall refer to the Center for Health Education and Wellness at The Johns Hopkins University.
- (g) Ace or Asexual The term "ace" or "asexual" shall refer to asexuality, a sexual orientation defined by the lack of sexual attraction.
- (h) Baila The term "Baila" shall refer to the Latin dance group at The Johns Hopkins University.

SECTION 3. FINDINGS AND PURPOSES

- (a) FINDINGS
 - (1) According to the <u>2018 OIE Report</u>, there were 465 counts of sexual misconduct reported in 2018.




Types of Sexual Misconduct Reported in 2018 (n = 465)

- (2) From 2017 to 2018, there has been a...
 - a. 37% increase in sexual misconduct
 - b. 65% increase in specified protected-class discrimination/harrassment
 - c. 226% increase in no protected class

Growth Within All Types of OIE Reports

OIE's growth in reports from the end of 2017 to the end of 2018 extended to reports of both sexual misconduct and protected-class discrimination or harassment.



- (3) This findings strongly suggest the need for greater sexual assault prevention, consent programming, and support for survivors on this campus.
- (4) This Sex Week <u>presentation</u> was given to the Student Government Association on Tuesday, March 3rd.

(b) PURPOSES

- (1) This act establishes funding for a week-long event filled with activities designed to increase sexual assault prevention, foster consent culture, and promote survivor advocacy. The month of April is also Sexual Awareness Month, which would make the timing of this event appropriate.
- (2) Beyond the theme of sex, this event aims to promote general body positivity and comfort with one's body. Sex Week will include a salsa dance class as well as an event for students on the asexuality spectrum.
- (3) Sex Week is in collaboration with the student organization SARU, the Office of LGBTO Life, and CHEW.
- (4) This bill lists out all the requested materials and their prices for Sex Week.
 - a. Costs for programming materials (Total: \$901.76)
 - b. Costs for services provided (Total: \$500)
 - c. Total Cost: \$1401.76

SECTION 4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Each day of the week will have a certain theme.

- (a) Monday- "Sex is Sexy"
 - a. Morning (10am-12pm) -- Tabling (Condoms, Stickers, Lube, Info Sheets) & Trivia at LEVERING COURTYARD

- i. How can sex be fun?
- b. Evening (6-8pm) -- Sex 101 with Domina (Dominatrix) in BARBER ROOM
 - i. Understanding what is pleasure and how to have pleasure
 - ii. Providing basic information on kink and BDSM (Bondage/Discipline, Dominance/Submission, and Sadism/Masochism)
 - iii. Practicing consent
- (b) Tuesday- "Sex is Consent"
 - a. Morning (10am-12pm) -- Tabling (Condoms, Stickers, Lube, Info Sheets) & Trivia at the BREEZEWAY
 - i. How do you give/get consent?
 - b. Evening -- Examining Consent in Movies (6-8pm) at ARELLANO THEATER
 - i. Catering provided
 - ii. Cup condoms will be given out to promote safe drinking practices and encourage sexual assault preventative measures.
- (c) Wednesday "Sex is Movement"
 - a. Morning (10am-12pm)
 - Tabling (Condoms, Stickers, Lube, Info Sheets) & Poster Board at BRODY TERRACE
 - 1. How do you get/give consent?
 - 2. What is something you wish we talked about when we talk about sex?
 - ii. Event Supporting Ace Students (10am-12pm on the Breezeway) at BRODY TERRACE
 - 1. Have people paint in ace colors and sign a banner pledging to be in support of ace students on campus
 - 2. Provide an event that is inclusive to students who are on the asexuality spectrum
 - 3. Paint, brushes, and poster paper will be provided through the LGBTQ Life Office.
 - b. Evening (4:30-6pm) -- Salsa Dance Class with Baila in the GREAT HALL
 - i. This event aims to promote body positivity by encouraging students to participate in a dance class.
- (d) Thursday- "Sex is Fun"
 - a. Morning -- Tabling (Condoms, Stickers, Lube, Info Sheets) & Poster Board at the BRODY TERRACE
 - i. What is something you wish we talked about when we talk about sex?
 - b. Evening -- Sex Toy Bingo! (7-9pm) in AMR I MPR
 - i. Snacks and prizes for Bingo winners provided
 - ii. Raffle for people who complete their Sex Week punchcard (3 punches)

- (e) Friday- "Sex and You"
 - a. Morning -- Tabling (Condoms, Stickers, Lube, Info Sheets) & Poster Board & Trivia at the BREEZEWAY
 - i. How did you think this week went? What did you like or dislike?
 - ii. What do you want to see more of next week?

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY

Should any provision of this Act, an amendment made by this Act, or the application of such provision or amendment to any person or circumstance is held to be unconstitutional, the remainder of this Act, the amendments made by this Act, and the application of such provision or amendment to any person or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

The Bill Hereby PASSES/FAILS by a vote of 26 to 0 with 0 abstentions.

Upon passage, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the seal of the Senate to be affixed to this bill indicating the Senate's assent and thus officially designated the bill's adoption as law.
