Mr. Bakenhaster- Into Math Module 16-Representing Fractions as a Whole Number

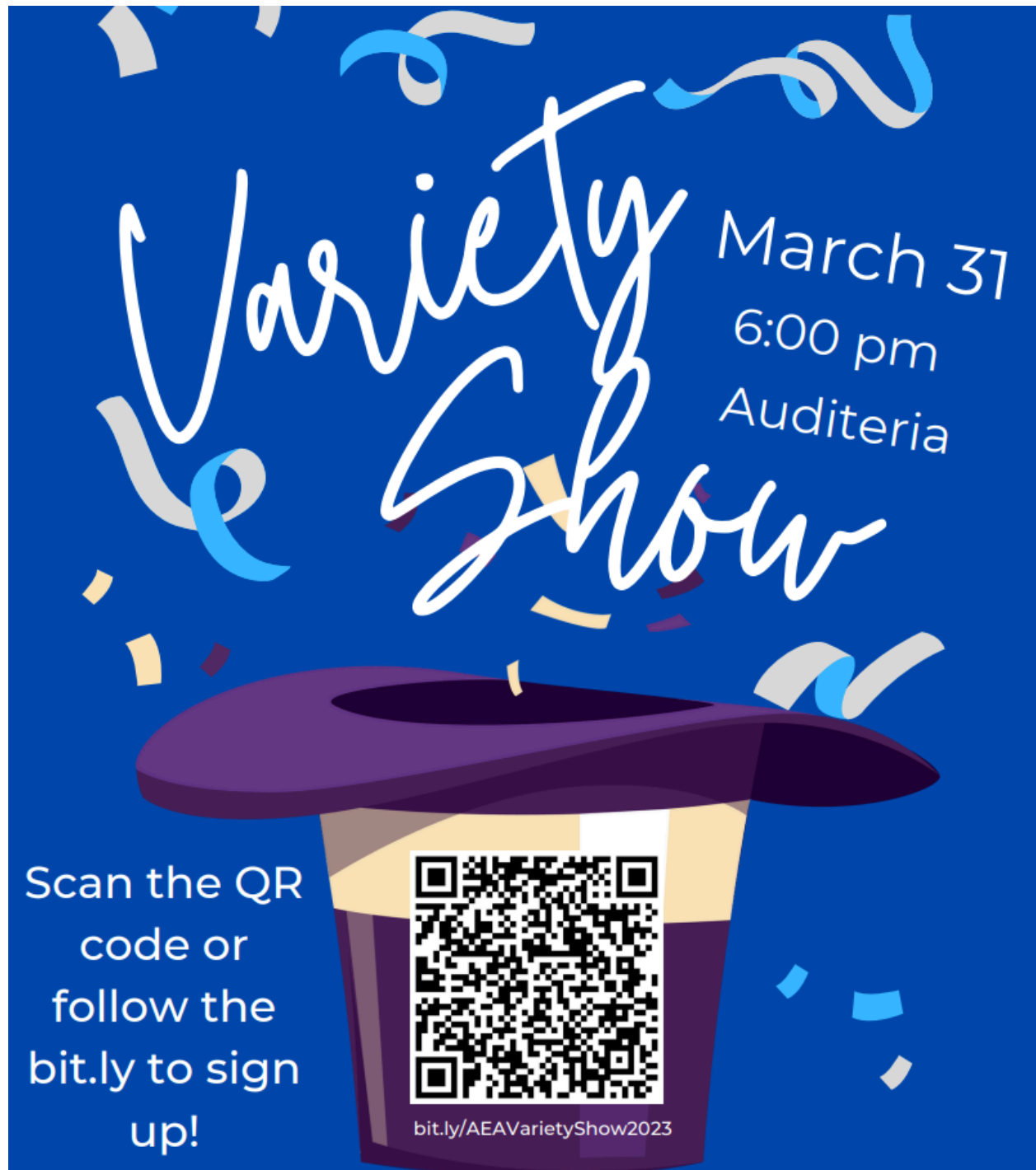
Science:
