Restroom

There will be a restroom in the classroom for only students to use. There will also be a sink outside of the classroom for students to regularly wash their hands.

Adaptations for students from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds

Weekly cover a new culture and background, for example a history lesson discuss the background of the people, for math include cultures in story problems

ABC posters with spanish alternative underneath (Spanish is a growing language in the US and we feel as though it is easier to implant at young ages rather than when they get older!)

Students with hearing impairments

Visuals, have charts on the walls, subtitles on all videos, and vocab words printed off for extra assistance.

Students with visual impairments

Large print is used on all forms of writing, charts, and worksheets, verbal cues are used, and extra time is given

Students with physical disabilities

Large aisle ways for students to get through, all student materials are at lower levels to be accessible, desks are together for a more organized and accessible path way, door frames can be extended

Students with seizures

Rubber mats under students desks for cushion, a resting area for students after a seizure

Students with behavior and attention disorders

Fidget bins, weighted blankets, timers on desks, and a picture schedule posted on the wall

Safety/Health

Bathroom with wide door frame and handicap accessible toilet, sink on the inside of bathroom and on the outside for student to wash their hands in the class, exits door frames are extra wide with a doorbell incase student needs assistance opening door due to full hands or wheelchair
