On 9 December 2010, the Executive Committee of the RNZA Association met at the Birkenhead RSA. This was their first meeting since the 76th Annual Reunion and AGM at Taupo last November.

Several committee tasks were allocated and Tony McLeod was appointed President to fill the vacancy left by Frank Hopkinson's retirement. Tony is also the Treasurer and Correspondence Secretary.
