The national soccer team, led by coach Jurgen Klinsmann, will play two consecutive games against Tunisia (Seoul) on the 13th and Vietnam (Suwon) on the 17th at Paju NFC on the 11th.

Some people are dissatisfied with the warm-up match against Vietnam on their home turf. It was criticized that there was no need to get many A-match opportunities against Vietnam, which has low objective power, and that there was no reason to pay invitation fees to Vietnam. 스포츠토토

However, the warm-up match against Vietnam did not incur any expenditures, including invitation fees as well as stay expenses.

An official from the Korea Football Association (KFA) said, "The game will be held in Korea, but we have been invited," adding, "We accepted the offer because we felt the need to play against Asian teams ahead of the Asian Cup."

"Usually, games held in Korea pay an invitation fee, but in the case of Vietnam, there is no invitation fee. Vietnam also pays for airfare and hotel accommodation, he said.

Meanwhile, Klinsmann is reportedly planning to grasp the level of Asian teams through the match against Vietnam and come up with countermeasures.

A KFA official said, "Clinzmann is not a major country, but he is not sure about the history of Asian teams. "Going to watch the Asian Football Confederation (AFC) Champions League (ACL) games is to check the overall level of Asia, although we also understand the power of our players," he hinted.
