Officer Position	Description
President and Treasurer School	Will preside over all meetings and vote in case of a tie. Will collect registration and fees for district events. May be assigned other duties as needed. This office consists of a two-year term: President and Treasurer School followed by Past President. This office will have two students: one as President and one as Treasurer.
Vice-President School	Will collect intent to run forms, verify accuracy, and create the ballot. May be assigned other duties as needed.
Secretary School	Will take and post minutes of stated meetings and board meetings and preside over the tabulations committee. May be assigned other duties as needed.
Parliamentarian School	Will oversee timing speeches and skits and verify the Elections. May be assigned other duties as needed.
Delegate at Large	Will collect ballots and give them to the secretary school's committee to count. May be assigned other duties as needed.
Nova Delegate	Will assist the executive board with duties as deemed necessary by the President School. May be assigned other duties as needed.
Historian	Will be responsible for social media and communication to members. May be assigned other duties as needed.

- ♦ **JC selection meeting.**
- ♦ Student representatives must attend the **3 organizational meetings** in addition to the **district conventions** and **any planning meetings** and **training for winter workshop**.
- ♦ If there is an advisor change during the summer, the new advisor must fulfill all these duties.
- ♦ If meetings are missed and duties are not performed, the school will be **removed from office as decided by the Executive Board**.

I understand that if I do not fulfill the responsibilities that I will be removed as a district officer. Campaign and Election Rules

Election Rules:

- o The candidate schools must have paid the current dues to TASC and District 713.
- o Candidate schools must file with the Vice President school by the assigned deadline and complete all Intent to Run for Office forms.
- o By the deadline if no school has filed for an office, the position will be appointed by the Board.
- o **No member school shall be elected to the same office two years in succession.**
- o Election of officer schools shall be a simple majority vote of the schools in attendance at the Spring Convention.
- o All candidates should have no outstanding balances with D713.
- o All newly elected or appointed officer schools shall assume their responsibilities at the end of the Spring Convention, after being sworn in. All newly elected or appointed officer schools are expected to make every effort to attend officer training and all D713 conventions/workshops in order to maintain office.
- o In the event of a tie when three or more candidates are running, a run-off vote will take place. In the event of a tie when only two schools are running, the President will flip a coin.
- o **All campaign rules must be followed or your school may be disqualified.**

Campaign Rules:

- o Must attend the Spring Convention to run in person.
- o Nominations:
 - Each candidate school will have a **non-officer school** nominate them for the office, which must be indicated on the Intent to Run before it is accepted. (For assistance in obtaining a nominating school, please contact the District Coordinators or Vice President School Advisor.)
- o Campaign Content/Skit/Video Guidelines:
 - **Including** the nomination, one-minute speech and presentation (video and/or skit), candidate schools shall have **4 minutes** to present their qualification for office. Each presentation will be timed by the Vice-President school. Timing will begin when the nominating school begins speaking.
 - **No pyramid building or gymnastics** in skits.
 - **Only School approved Social Media Accounts. No personal accounts allowed for campaigning.**
 - **Emails sent to District 713** schools introducing your school and platform are allowed.
 - Skit participants may wear costumes, but **costumes must have board approval through Vice President School.** School t-shirts are suggested, **No campaign t- shirts allowed. All costumes must follow the TASC dress code.**
 - Skits may have a **dance** included, but **dances and music must have board approval through the Vice President School.**
 - Students **cannot buy their own props** for the skit. The maximum amount spent on skit materials is \$50.00. All receipts are due to the Parliamentarian by April 13th via Email..
