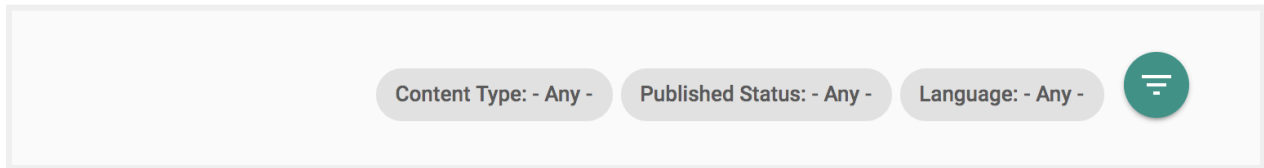
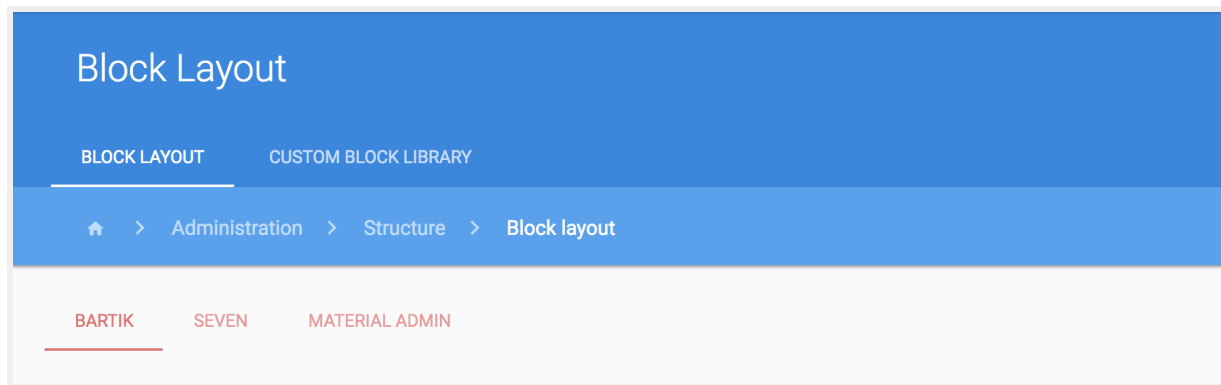


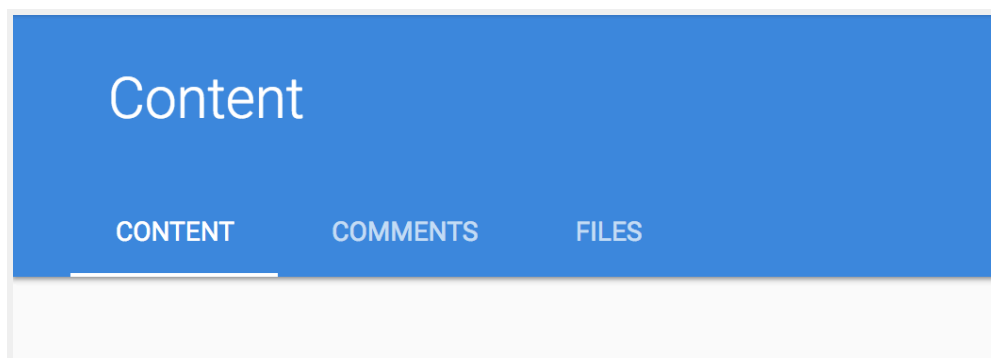
First of this. No problem with it, just thank you. It's a thing of beauty.



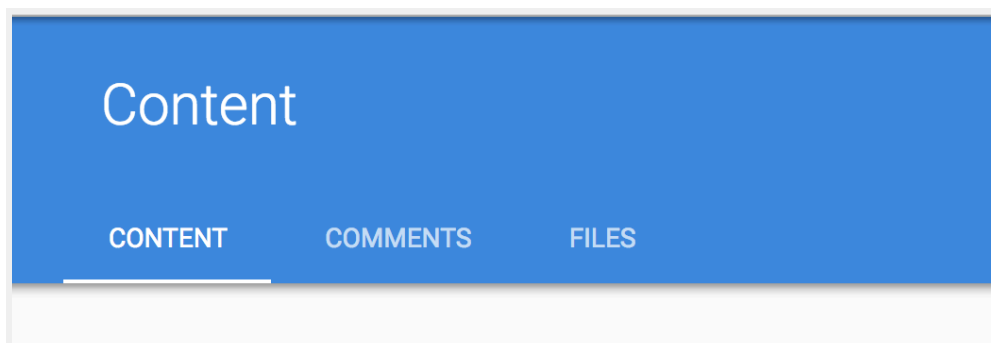

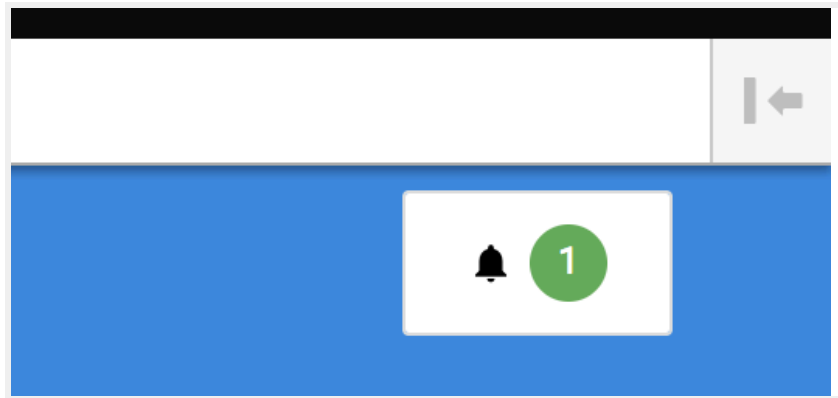
When I take them out the shadow looks awkward with the underline.



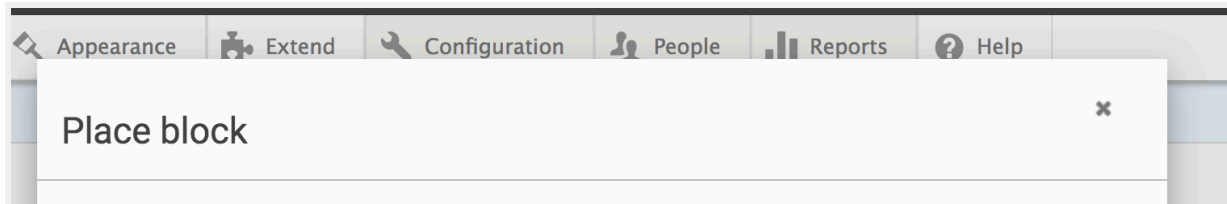
Looks a bit better with .z-depth-2



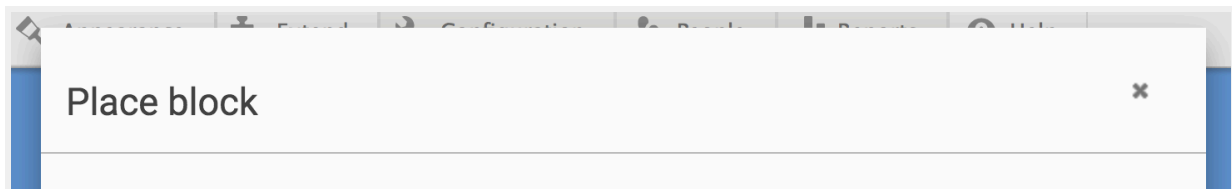
I like this but it feels 'stuck on' it really belongs in the toolbar (I understand the problem with that) but in this context maybe white icon, white circle, green number?



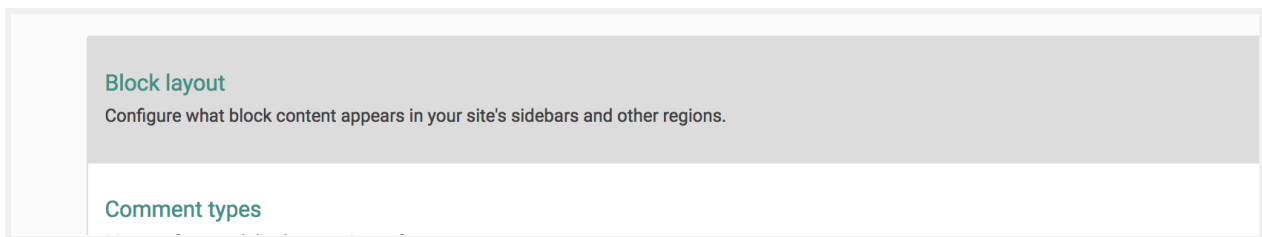
In the modal the close button is awkwardly positioned.



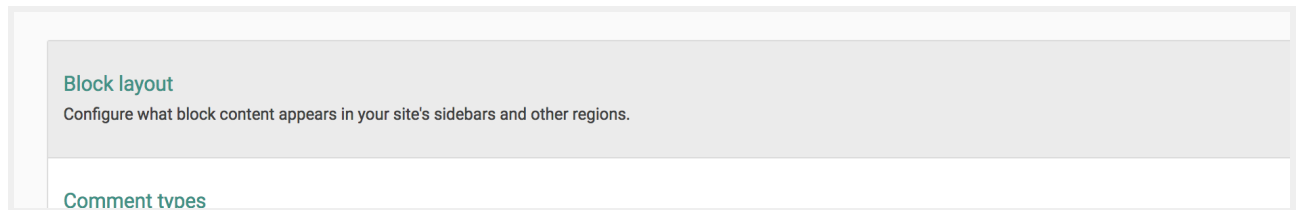
If you take out the absolute top value it centers nicely.



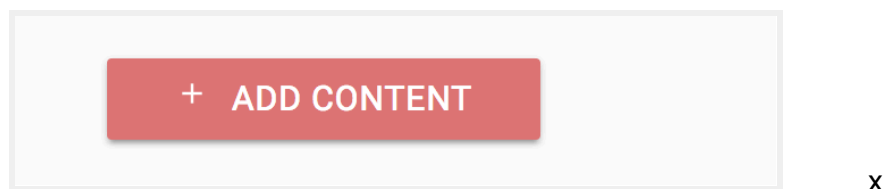
On the hover state for list items and rows I think the contrast with the heading is too low for WCAG.



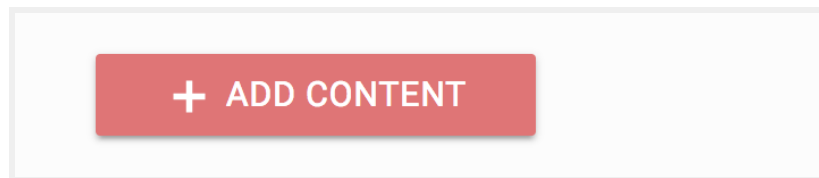
I think #eee would be better.

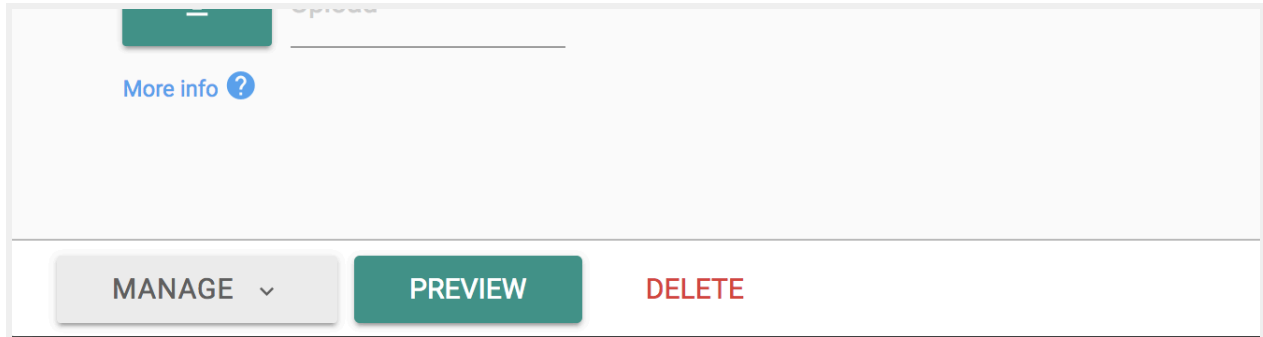
Or alternately just make some tweaks.



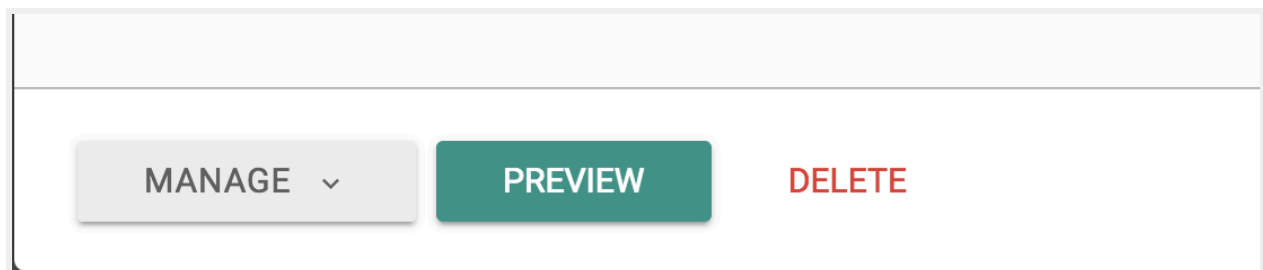
The position of the checkinside the checkbox looks a bit high. Top: 2px fixes it.
