

Impulse Youth Club Chaperone Expectations <u>Updated April 2025</u>

Each Youth Club team is required to have <u>at least</u> two official chaperones for every travel tournament. These two adults (per team, per weekend) will have specific duties and will maintain a direct relationship with Pittsburgh Ultimate staff.

Note: Tournament/team chaperones may differ from those listed on the team's USA Ultimate roster.

Specific duties of the Youth Club chaperones are listed below. Overall, chaperones must exhibit a high level of professionalism and dedication to the Spirit of the Game, and their athlete's team, coaches, and players.

General

- Be a positive and supportive role model
- Supervise all team and athlete activities when coaches are not present
 - May not require you to be present at the field site all day; just let us know in advance if you have other plans during the day so we can communicate pickup times for players
- Facilitate communication between coaches and other parents/families
- Disperse first aid items (coaches have) and assist with additional supplies as needed

Travel Logistics

- Travel with the athletes to, from, and during the tournament
- ***Chaperones are not required to stay at the same lodging as Impulse 2025
- Help coordinate pick-up and drop off of athletes
- Rent/pick up/drop off team rental vehicles if needed (typically just for YCCs)
- Plan, facilitate, and/or purchase team field food and team meals as needed
- Plan and/or facilitate team laundry efforts (typically not necessary)

Finances

- Can utilize Pittsburgh Ultimate team/coach credit card if needed
- Keep, track, and forward all receipts to Pittsburgh Ultimate staff for reimbursement
- This is a volunteer position. YCCs flights/lodging costs/meals will not be covered by Pittsburgh Ultimate.

 Rentals cars (only for full time YCCs chaperones whom we designate) and gas/tolls for tournaments are covered.

Clearances

- We are not requiring chaperone clearances for 2025 (as our coaching staff is all cleared through USAU and PGH Ultimate and will be present with the team throughout the tournaments)
- If you are acting as a formal USA Ultimate Chaperone, you may be responsible for additional requirements
- Highly encouraged: Complete a free online training in both Cardiac Arrest and Concussions (~30 minutes each)
