Writing About An Illustration

When writing something about a character or an illustration, you must look at them carefully and be sure of what is illustrated.



Look at the picture.

Say something about it.

The possible answer that you might think of is that "It is a wig." And you are right!

Let us be more specific about the illustration.

When you are asked to say something about the illustration, you can start by identifying what is in the picture.

Example: wig

To be a little specific, you can use other words to tell something about it:

Example: a wig

the wig

or add any describing word that is also shown in the picture:

Example: a curly wig

a black wig

Finally, you can also write a complete sentence about it.

Example: It is a curly wig.

The wig is black.
