Public hearings are coming up on National Grid's plan to build two Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) vaporizers in Greenpoint and a utility rate hike to pay for it.

In August, the investor-owned utility submitted a report to the Public Service Commission asking for an independent review of the new LNG vaporizers they want to build along the Newtown Creek, and the "cost recovery" from consumers they're seeking. Part of that review involves public input from impacted residents, including you.

This is an important opportunity for North Brooklyn residents to let environmental and utility regulators know how you feel about expanding fossil infrastructure in our backyard.
