We do have to list the CSET and CBEST exams, as both of them are ways to meet those requirements. So, you will see that language on the checklist. But, you will also see that they can request a verification form from their Advisor. We've included the BSR 41 and the SMR verification forms. We've included the list of degrees in the handbook. The same is true for the CBEST, but the form is called <u>BSR-41</u>. In EDU 503, the first course in all teacher credentialing programs, students are given the <u>Student Checklist</u>, which explains requirements as they progress.
