Activity: The King of Kindergarten Storyline Online Read Aloud

Target Age: 4-5 yrs

Description: Watch the read aloud. Consider the following discussion

questions:

Before Reading:

- What does it mean to be 'king' of something?
- How could someone be the King of Kindergarten?
- What might happen in this story? (predictions)

During Reading:

- Why did Mommy say the little boy would be the King of Kindergarten?
- What do you do after you wake up? Draw a comparison with the main character.

After Reading:

• How did the main character show he was the King of Kindergarten?
