Unreadit soft launched 2 days back to send you the best of Reddit in your inbox, every week /r https://unread.it/

On their website they mention using a special algorithm to surface the best content (read: tame the monster to spill out the good beans \bigoplus)

Personally Handcrafted

The Brain Food Weekly Digest by @farnamstreet
