What's the Difference Between a Loaned Device and an #OaklandUndivided Device?

LOANER Chromebooks and Hotspots

Loaner Chromebooks

- Provided by your student's school as a "loaned" device that your student will need to return
- May be new or used condition but often used
- Will likely have a school or district logo on the cover
- Managed by your school or district so content-filtering is included
- Often has a sticker on it so it can be tracked by the school or district



Example: Oakland Unified Loaner Chromebook

Loaner Hotspots

- Provided by your student's school as a "loaned" device that your student will need to return
- May be in new or used condition
- May be a smartphone or a hotspot
- Loaners from OUSD have Sprint service with 10GB of data monthly

#OAKLANDUNDIVIDED Chromebooks and Hotspots

#OaklandUndivided Chromebooks

- Provided by your student's school as an #OaklandUndivided laptop your student will keep
- Managed by the student or parent
- Content filtering is not included, parents must add parental controls to devices
- Brand new condition
- Will have the logo for #OaklandUndivided on the cover

#OaklandUndivided Hotspots

- Provided by your student's school as a #OaklandUndivided hotspot with free service for 2 years
- Brand new condition
- Hotspot with free unlimited high speed service from T-Mobile
