General Health Class and Family Health

Family Health - Elective Class

Outcomes

1. I can identify and label a diagram of male/female reproductive organs.
2. I can explain reproductive organs' functions and disorders that can occur.
3. I can identify the process of physical exams for adult males and females.
4. I can explain the symptoms, modes of transmission, consequences, and how to prevent transmission of sexually transmitted infections.
5. I can identify the barriers to condom use and steps for correct condom use as a risk reduction strategy
6. I can identify and describe the positive and negative characteristics of other contraceptive methods

Goals

By the end of the reproductive health unit, 80% of students will demonstrate that they understand the basic reproductive organs and their functions, as well as disorders that can occur and what could put the reproductive system at risk - as measured by pre-test and post-test data.

By the end of the reproductive health unit, 80% of students will demonstrate an understanding of how to successfully prevent STI transmission through use of both abstinence and different contraceptive methods (abstinence being the only 100% effective method) measured by post-test data.

General Health Class - Required Health Class

Outcomes

1. I can explain the symptoms, modes of transmission, consequences, and how to prevent transmission of six sexually transmitted infections: HIV, chlamydia, gonorrhea, genital warts, herpes, and syphilis.
2. I can define the terms sex, sexuality, sexual activity, abstinence, and sexual intercourse.
3. I can identify limits for personal behavior and influences that encourage and/or discourage risky behaviors and refusal skills.
4. I can identify the age of consent and the consequences of underage sex
5. I can explain Michigan's Safe Delivery of Newborns Law.
6. I can distinguish between the criteria for selecting friends and potential romantic partners.
7. I can identify the four domains of intimacy.

Goals

By the end of the reproductive health unit, 80% of students will demonstrate an Understanding of healthy relationships, HIV and other STIs, and relevant laws pertaining to sexual activity as measured by the final unit assessment.
