As a teen, Alexandra began to hang out around the clubhouse mostly around the guys. She'd spend time in the automotive shop learning to repair motorcycles and cars.

During that time Alexandra fell into their ways of hooking up at parties and club events that her father let her attend.

Various members from the Sons other charters would show up and Alexandra would hang around them with until one would decide to take her back to their room when Clay wasn't looking. Showing the guys even she wouldn't shy away from one night stand.

But deep down wanted to become of the ol' ladies think it was her only destiny in life. To end up entangled in the club as a member's wife.

After high school Alexandra took a year off. She'd decided against going to college and instead took a job at Teller-Morrow helping her mom with administrative work. As well as helping customers who'd come in to get their cars fixed, or go out when calls for a tow came in. She also thought she couldn't find a biker if she left.

But one day at the garage while her family and half the guys were in Belfast to get her nephew Abel back from the Irish. Unser, and Stahl had paid Tig and the remaining guys to help get Tara and Margret back from being kidnapped.

She became intrigued by thought of wearing a badge but knew being a cop in this life was all but forbidden. Cops were an enemy to the club and even worse she may be seen as a rat.

A few days later Alexandra decided to apply to the police academy knowing both her parents would disapprove, her mom was framed for Eddie Hayes murder. And her father, and most the club were in trouble on a federal gun charge from the ATF facing serious time.

Due to her connections to the Sons and the pending charges against her dad, Alexandra's application was rejected. But Charming's police chief Wayne Unser saw promise and wanted better for Gemma's daughter so he wrote a letter for Alexandra convincing her to try again. And this led to her being accepted the second time.

Clay found out about his daughter's sudden dream to become a cop when they'd returned from Ireland and told her it wouldn't be without working for the club. He asked for the same 'understanding' he had with Unser with his daughter too.

For four years, Alexandra worked as an Officer for the Charming Police Department under Wayne Unser starting as a patrol cop. During which she was forced to get the club out of legal troubles and do whatever else her president father asked.

Her brother Jax having partnered with Nero Padilla, an owner of an escort agency called Diosa, uses his share to also help his sister pay for school.

During the summers, Alexandra spends time with the Daughters looking after club business and working in the mail room at Ally Lowen's law firm. With hopes that she'll be taken on as a employee.

Upon graduating, Alexandra is also retained as the Daughters' lawyer and takes a job at Lowen's Law firm exclusively focusing on the club and other clients away from SAMCRO.

Alexandra soon learns from Jax of her father's exile from the club, and knows after that he's living on borrowed time.

After Jax tells her about Clay's eventual death, Alexandra sells the family home after Gemma told her she can't stay there. She uses the money to buy herself a condo in the same city, as the Daughters' clubhouse.

Alexandra grows closer to Jax, and their mom doing things they'd never got the chance to do when Clay was alive. She helps Gemma out, as well providing the future that her father couldn't with Jax's help.
