- As the bombing and humanitarian crisis in Rafah worsens it is paramount we take a stance against the brutal slaughter of an entire group of people. 1.9 million people are trapped in an open air prison;
- Israeli airstrikes have targeted refugee camps and hospitals, and decimated entire neighborhoods. Over 1.9 million Palestinians are displaced or homeless.
- The Israeli government is now bombing the entirety of Gaza, including areas that they ordered people to evacuate to. The UN clearly stated that right now, "there are no safe places in Gaza."
- The context of 75 years of occupation and apartheid is still glaringly missing from the mainstream conversation.
- The Palestinian struggle is a human struggle just as slavery and Apartheid were and it's imperative, especially during Black History Month, to never forget that fact.]
