

Encore Level 2 Test Review

THEORY CONCEPTS

Recognize and draw all components of the Grand Staff (treble or G clef, bass or F clef, staff, lines, spaces, bar line, measures, double bar, brace).

Write the musical alphabet forward and backward.

Identify all notes of the Middle C position, and all notes on the staff lines and spaces.

Write in counting for an excerpt in 4/4, 3/4 or 2/4.

Know where to find the time signature, and how to determine the number of beats per measure.

Write and identify intervals from a 2nd through 5th.

Understand the difference between ties and slurs.

Draw and identify the following note and rest values: whole, dotted half, half, quarter. Know the number of beats each receives.

Draw and identify half steps and whole steps.

Understand the construction of a major five-finger pattern and draw this pattern in C, G, and F. Know how to build a major triad from this pattern.

Know how to make a minor five-finger pattern from a major five-finger pattern (cm, gm, fm). Know how to build a minor triad from this pattern.

Draw the major key signatures for C, G, F.

1. Name two periods of music.

1. You will hear two pitches. Is the second one higher or lower than the first?
2. You will hear two rhythmic patterns. Is the second one the same as the first or different?
3. You will hear two melodic patterns. Is the second one the same as the first or different?
4. You will hear an interval. Is it a perfect fifth (PS) or a minor second (m2)?
5. You will hear a five-finger pattern. Is it major or minor?
6. The melodies below use only the three notes of the C major chord. Fill in the missing final note. (Be sure you draw the correct type of note: quarter, half, dotted half, whole.)
