- 1) Greek or Latin courses numbered 101-102, 201, and 301 count towards the language requirement. Students who enter Puget Sound with some Latin or Greek should consult with a faculty member about placement.
- 2) Greek 301 and Latin 301 satisfy the Arts & Humanities Division requirement. Greek 301 and Latin 301 count towards both division and language requirements. Greek or Latin 301 may be repeated for credit.
- 3) Courses are from the following list: ARTH 275, 360, 361, 362; CONN 377; ENGL 353; GLAM 100, 110, 111, 120, 130, 180, 181, 230, 231, 232, 233, 280, 322, 323, 330, 339, 375; GRK 201, 301; HIST 112, 304; LAT 201, 301; PG 340; PHIL 210, 310; SOAN 280; STHS 201. These ARTH, ENGL, GLAM, and PHIL courses also satisfy the AR/HM Division requirement. SOAN 280 and STHS 201 satisfy the SS/HS Division.
- 4) GLAM 180 and 181 are offered in alternating years. GLAM 180 and 181 satisfy the EL requirement.

**Students considering graduate school should choose the Greek and Latin Language major rather than the Ancient Mediterranean Studies major and consult with a member of the GLAM faculty as soon as possible about appropriate preparation for graduate study.**
