Bubbly, extroverted, and cuttingly sarcastic, Flora is the poster child for the classic "mean girl"— a woman who belongs more in the cutthroat cliques of high school than an actual political office. With an Origin mother and a father with more pocket change than common sense, Flora is **used to leveraging her status** to get what she wants, when she wants.

Yet, even the shiniest of titles do not exist without some sense of hard work. While Flora was born with a silver spoon dangling from her mouth, many of her current achievements have also been borne of her own efforts. For one, she is a two-time valedictorian, both in high school and within her college. When she isn't spending her time chasing fame, partying, or schmoozing with those in charge, she is ruthless in conquering every other facet of her life, boasting a set of rituals and routines that are frankly Bateman-esque. Her coworkers hate her for the extra work she tacks onto their plates. But her spin class adores her for the same reasons, citing her energy and willingness to push things to the limit as her best traits.

Regardless of how deeply she entangles herself in her pursuit of perfection, Flora has never been able to shake the truth that she is an Offprint, not an Origin. There is a fragility to her success—the permanent distance between Sleeping Beauty and her children has led Flora to believe that she was never enough in her mother's eyes, and she constantly works to prove, not only to her mother but to herself, that she can build herself into a daughter Sleeping Beauty is proud of.

Because of this, Flora can be volatile. When she does end up in a situation that isn't in her favor, she comes across as petulant at best and downright unhinged at her worst. To her, perfection is a necessity. Those who prove a threat to her name (or, gods forbid, her mother's name) may be surprised to find Flora's fits to be not as sheltered as their host. A dangerous tension underlies her bubblegum-pink exterior; those who have identified it within her can only pray it never snaps.

fanfare, with all of Neverland acting as witnesses to the miracle of her birth. The girl was the eldest of a pair of twins— when Sleeping Beauty first cradled the child in her arms, she named her Flora, after the leader of the good fairies, and her sister, Merryweather, after the fairy with the most heart.
