

Privacy Policy for Quick URL Shortcuts

Thank you for using Quick URL Shortcuts. This privacy policy explains what information the extension handles and why.

Data We Handle

The only data the extension handles is the list of URL shortcuts that you create and save yourself. This includes the shortcut keyword (e.g., "g/") and the corresponding full URL (e.g., "<https://google.com>").

This information is considered your personal content.

How We Use Your Data

The shortcut data you create is used for the single, core purpose of the extension: to allow you to quickly navigate to your saved URLs from the browser's address bar. The extension reads your saved shortcuts to find a match for the keyword you type.

Data Storage

Your shortcut data is stored locally on your computer using Chrome's built-in storage.sync API. This also allows your shortcuts to be synced across your devices where you are logged into the same Google account.

We, the developers of Quick URL Shortcuts, do not have access to this data. It is never transmitted to our servers or any third-party service.

Data Sharing

We do not collect, store, or share any of your personal information or shortcut data. Because we never have access to your data, we cannot and will not share it with anyone.
