## 1st Quarter

- EL #1 Pitch Reading
  - Students can recognize, read, understand, and apply pitches in a given meter, both simple and compound
- EL #2 Rhythm Reading
  - Students can recognize, read, understand, and apply rhythms in a given key signature and clef
- EL #3 Select and Develop musical ideas for defined purposes and contexts.
  - Students can identify and describe the development of sounds or short musical ideas with in simple forms
- EL #4 Share creative musical work that conveys intent, demonstrates craftsmanship, and exhibits originality.
  - Students can share music through the use of notation, performance, or technology, and demonstrate how the elements of music have been employed to realize expressive intent.
