These banners—measuring **48 x 24 inches**—will be proudly displayed on utility poles throughout the town center. But the heart of each banner will be a **showcase of local artwork**, with a **36 x 24-inch space** dedicated to images that represent what Malta means to its artists—whether it's the beauty of our parks, the dedication of our volunteers, the warmth of family, or the vibrant hometown activities we all cherish.

We are inviting community members to **submit their artwork**—whether it's a **photo**, **sketch**, **watercolor**, **or any creative expression**—for a chance to be featured. Community members can send a photograph of their work to the Rotary's email address, <u>MaltaNYRotary@gmail.com</u> until July 1, 2025. Malta League of Arts has information posted on their website too. We will announce which works will be featured at a reception on July 24th at the Malta Community Center between 6-7:30 PM. The art will be on display at the center in photographic form for two weeks. The works will also be on display at the Round Lake Auditorium during their August Tea and Tour days. We are working on having a slideshow of the works for other community venues to use while the banners are being produced. The banners, created by an East Greenbush company, Gettysburg Flags, will be gifted to the town prior to Malta Community Day on September 13th.
