Former Rolla man killed by Texas cops

Christopher Lewis, son of Dave Lewis, of Rolla, owner of the building at 118 W. 8th St. (formerly Jimmy's Deli & Pub and now T.J.'s) was shot and killed last Tuesday, Jan. 9, by Dallas, TX police when he brandished a handgun, according to a story in the Dallas Morning News. The story said Christopher Lewis, 34, of Garland, TX died at Parkland Memorial Hospital where he was taken after the incident.

The police report said police responded to a call from a woman in an apartment who said that her ex-boyfriend was in her apartment. Officers found a vehicle believed to be connected to the suspect and saw him approach it. When officers tried to confront the man, he displayed a handgun and was apparently immediately shot by police.

The man was later identified as Christopher Lewis.
