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Fakemon Community Collab 2024

Thank you for considering participating in this challenge. We hope you have fun!

This document contains all the information a participant of the FCC 2024 needs to know to take part in the event.

How do I partake?

To participate in the challenge you will need to make one or more fan-made Pokemon based on the theme of **Inversion**.

Publicly share these fakemon in the form of a single YouTube video. No later than the start of 2025.

And no earlier than August 1st 2024.

Your job as a participant is to make your own unique theme inversion and create one or more fakemon based on the inverted archetype. How many evolutionary lines and individual fakemon you make is completely up to you.

In the description or the title of your YouTube video you must include the hashtag of #fakemoncommunitycollab2024.

In your video, clarify that absolutely any fakemon creator with a YouTube channel is allowed to participate. And direct your audience of potential participants to open this document if they would like to partake in the challenge.

Make sure to include a link to this document in the description of your video, so that your audience can easily access it.

The thumbnail of your video should include the FCC 2024 logo. (Created by RedParagonG). Simply navigate to the link at the top of this document to download the logo.

And this is optional. But it's tradition to tag 3 other YouTube creators to participate in the challenge as well, at the end of your own video. If you don't know any other Fakemon creators, or would like to just tag 1 or 2 creators, then that's fine as well.

If you still are having trouble figuring out what this event is about. Feel free to check out some of the other videos from this event from all years since its inception back in 2022. Those videos can be found in this playlist. Keep in mind though that the previous iterations of this event had different prompts.

What is inversion?

It's the reversal or opposite of a commonly known theme or archetype. For example, Cats hate water. An inversion of this would be a cat that loves water. Another could be how sunflowers face toward the sun. The inversion would be a sunflower that actively avoids it.

Rules

In order for you to be counted in the official collaboration we kindly ask you to follow some of these simple rules in order to help get others involved and prevent anarchy.

1. The Fakemon(s) that you create for this wondrous event must not follow any secondary guidelines. You can add any inspiration you want. All we ask is that it follows the theme of Inversion. Any other inspirations are entirely up to you. Let your imagination run wild.

2. Include the hashtag for this challenge in the description or title of your video. The hashtag is #fakemoncommunitycollab2024.
3. Make your video before 2025. This is the 2024 FCC so this should go without saying. We will make a new prompt in 2025 so publishing it then could cause confusion for other participants.
4. Clearly explain the prompt/theme. And how your mon fits into the prompt/theme to your viewers, especially if it's a real stretch on it.
5. You can stretch the theming of your mon however you want as long as it technically fits the theme of inversion we have stated. The thing you're inverting has to be "common knowledge" or at least something that is specific to our understanding. As long as the Fakemon fits the theme, nobody including us veterans of the challenge cannot control how you make your mon. You get to choose everything about it including how it fits the theme.
6. We urge you to watch other videos for this challenge, so you don't overlap themes. If you see the challenge and work on an inversion but someone swoops in and does it before you. We won't ask you to remake it from scratch. Just, at least have a different interpretation. That is the only excuse for overlaps, as we'd like to see the creativity and uniqueness here.
7. Post a link in the description to this document, so willing participants can read the information, read the rules, watch the videos of other participants and even past years episodes and spread it to everyone you know so they can join in on the fun.
8. The final and most important rule... Is to have fun. This was created by a group of friends to share entertainment through Fakemon, and now it is evolving into something that should be fun for everybody given how other... events have caused hardships for the Fakemon community. We should help each other strengthen our skills, our channels, and our bonds and what better way than through Fakemon.
