Re: Kenosha Bradford H.S. Red Devil Invitational- Saturday April 26, 2025

History: When the new Bradford H.S. opened in the fall of 1980, Bradford hosted a boys only indoor relay meet for 14 years from 1981 to 1994. Starting in 1995, the meet format was changed to a boys only invitational and ran for another 17 years until 2011. At that time, varsity meets were just starting to be held on 200 meter tracks and the meet was cancelled due to a lack of interest. We have now reinstated the invitational to a coed outdoor event with the building of our new Mary D. Bradford Stadium. This will be our **39th Annual Red Devil Invitational**, which for the seventh year will be held on

our new outdoor track. We are very excited to have brought back this event as the meet was not held for five years from 2012-2016 and in 2020 due to the COVID-19 virus.

General Information:

- Providing Fully Automatic Timing by Track Side Timing
- Allowing 3 individual Varsity entries per running event + 1 Varsity relay team entries per event
- 3 Varsity entries in shot put, discus, long jump, and triple jump. Implements will be weighed in SW team room

Facility: The track was installed by AFS. It is a Seal-Flex Beynon polyurethane surface. The Mary D. Bradford Stadium track has nine 42" lanes on the curves and on the straights. Long and triple jump pits are at the southeast corner of the stadium and can be contested in either the north or south direction. The pole vault runway extends east/west on the south end of the track with a box at both ends. The high jump pad is located on the north end of the track. The shot and discus pads are located outside the fence on the southeast corner of the stadium. No Locker rooms available.

Entries Limits: Athletes may compete in 4 events as per WIAA rules. *Coaches will need to list their relay team individual members in case a meet record is set.

Submit entry: Entries will only be accepted online through MileSplit Wisconsin. Coaches can access on-line entry directly at wi.milesplit.com or at www.tracksidetiming.com. Instructions for first time account set up and registration are posted at www.tracksidetiming.com. Plan accordingly and give yourself at least 48 hours to create your account and upload your roster. The meet is titled "Red Devil Invite" in wi.milesplit.com. Log in to your account and find the meet in the calendar. All entries must be submitted by Thursday April 24th by 8:00PM for this meet. Meet information, heat sheets, and results will be posted at www.tracksidetiming.com.

Scratches: Please limit your scratches as much as possible, but we will allow for only a maximum of 2 scratches with replacements. Also, you may not scratch an athlete from one event and then add them to another event.

Officials: Matt DeWitt, Kurt Jones, Tim Shore, and Jean Goedel

Scoring: All Varsity events will be scored with places 1-8. (10-8-6-5-4-2-1).

Awards: Specially designed Red Devil Invitational Medals by Jostens will be given for places 1st-2nd-3rd, including relays. Also Championship Trophies will be

given out to each of the 1st place teams for boys and girls. Awards can be picked up in the press box after the meet.

- Tents:** Team tents may be set up on the grass area on the southwest/northwest side of the stadium's main bleachers.
- Info. Packets:** Pick up meet information upon arrival in the southeast team room on the track side of the concession building.
- Clothing:** A variety of t-shirts (long and short), and sweat shirts will be available by Fine Designs for the Red Devil Invitational. Logo to be sent in advance.
- Trainer:** A CAT will be on hand at the meet
- Spikes:** 1/4" pyramid spikes are the maximum allowed. NO pins or Christmas tree spikes allowed. Spikes will be checked during event check in. HJ/LJ/TJ/PV surface is the same as the track.
- Clerking:** Running event check in with the clerk will be at the start of the 100 Meters on the north end of the track. A table will be set up behind the finish line to pick up hip numbers.
- Announcer:** Jerry Munia, a retired track coach from Oak Creek HS, and Tom Roders, a former Bradford track coach (1975-1988) will be meet announcers.
- Results:** Results will be announced after each event is determined to be final. Meet results can be found at www.tracksidetiming.com. Also during the meet, live results will be available.
- Admission:** There will be a charge for admission which will be done online. A link will be sent along with this meet information. Also \$4.00 cash at the gate.
- Rest Rooms:** Located at the front of the concession building at the south end of the track at the entrance.
- Concessions:** There will be a concession stand available. However, doughnuts and a lunch will be provided for the coaches and officials.
