Habakkuk 2:3b-4

NT fulfillment: Rom. 1:17, Gal. 3:11, Hb. 10:38

- 1) Rom. 1:17 salvation comes to Jew and Greek (Gentile) alike because it comes only by “faith”
- 2) Gal. 3:11 no one is justified by the law and old covenant but only by faith
- 3) Hb. 10:37-38 (LXX) judgment will not delay for those who turn from Christ

Woes show these people are:

- 1) proud, arrogant, and glory seeking
- 2) greedy
- 3) violent
- 4) socially unjust
- 5) sexually immoral
- 6) drinkers
- 7) idolaters

-Shigionoth = “after the manner of a stormy, martial, and triumphal ode”

-Selah = “strengthening of musical accompaniment”; most likely the blast of a trumpet
