In 6th Grade Math, students will carry forward the skills and knowledge they obtained in 5th grade and previous grades and will build upon those skills as well as introducing the following skills and concepts using 6th Grade Alabama Standards and Objectives:

- use positive rational numbers
- integers and rational numbers
- numeric and algebraic expressions
- represent and solve equations and inequalities
- understand and use ratio and rate
- understand and use percent
- solve area, surface area, and volume problems
- display, describe, and summarize data

All grades count as the following:

- 45% tests/projects
- 35% quizzes
- 20% classwork/participation

Students will have weekly Bellringer Quizzes, Topic Tests at the end of each topic, participation grades for group work, and other various grades throughout the week/month.

Students who do not follow directions will face the following consequences:

- 1st time: warning
- 2nd time: parent contact
- 3rd time: break detention
- 4th time: break detention/phone or in person parent conference with student
- 5th time: referral to office
