Nyah Project Passport Instructions

All participants must have an official **passport** in order to participate in the Global Youth Leadership Fellowship.

If you don't yet have a US Passport, please apply immediately.

If you have a non-US passport, please inform Nyah Project staff as entry visa requirements may differ for fellowship travel.

Nyah Project Deadlines

If you do not have a passport, or your passport will expire in the next 12 months, please apply immediately and let us know that you are in the process of obtaining a US Passport. Note that we often must apply for international visas for entry to our fellowship destination, so it is important to have your valid passport on hand by the stated program deadlines to meet travel participation deadlines.

Ex: If you apply in Spring 2024 for the 2024-'25 Global Youth Leadership Fellowship and are selected, your cohort will travel the summer of 2025 (the end of the 14 month fellowship program). You need a passport valid through December 21, 2025.
