Cancellations and Refunds

If the cancellation of a scheduled activity is encountered, we will endeavor to provide a suitable substitute if at all possible.

Disabilities and Special Needs

Prime Tours makes every effort to contract with providers of transportation which fully comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you have special travel or accommodation needs, you must notify us in writing as to the nature of any special accommodations or needs you may require. Prime Tours nor any of the providers of transportation, lodging, or entertainment can ensure special accommodations without advance notice. Passengers requiring special assistance, including without limitation those who permanently or periodically use a wheelchair, must be accompanied by someone who is fit and able to assist them, and who will be completely responsible for providing all required assistance. The right is reserved to decline to accept or retain any person as a member of this trip who, in the opinion of Prime Tours, is unfit for travel or whose physical or mental condition may constitute a danger to themselves or to others on the trip.

Changes Due to External Events Beyond Prime Tours Control

Travel Insurance
