How to Use Saber Plug-in w/After Effects

To Make a Simple LightSaber

- 1. Navigate to the 3rd Party Plug-in Saber by CoPilot and download
- 2. Double click on .exe file and install
- 3. Open After Effects
- 4. Import your image or image sequence or video file
- 5. Make a new composition with your footage
- 6. Add a solid layer on Top of your footage
- 7. From Effects and Presets search for Saber
- 8. Drag Saber effect on to your solid layer to add effect
- 9. You can choose to use the Saber, Apply Effect to a mask or to text
- 10. There are lots of settings to change the look of your effect experiment
- 11. To show your effect on the layer below, choose Screen as your blending mode

To Apply to Text (most basic)

- 1. Create a new composition
- 2. Add a solid background layer, name it background
- 3. Add a text layer and type anything you want
- 4. Add a solid layer black name SaberEffectsLayer to stay organized
- 5. Apply the Saber effect to this layer
- 6. On your SaberEffectsLayer look for the Customize Core Option
- 7. Under Core Type, choose Text Layer and select that text
- 8. You can turn off the Text layer to just reveal the outlines of the text

To Create a Mask that glows

- 1. Create a new composition
- 2. Add a solid layer or add an image
- 3. If you add an image, duplicate it
- Add Saber Effect to your solid layer or the duplicated image, blend mode Screen or go to Alpha Mode on the Effect and change to transparent
- 5. With that layer selected, draw a mask with pen tool or with a shape
- 6. Under Customize Core/Core Type choose Layer Mask

To Create a Mask that Tracks

- 1. Create a new composition
- 2. Add your Video Footage
- 3. Duplicate it
- 4. Draw out a mask
- 5. Right click on mask and choose track
- 6. Adjust track as necessary
- 7. Add Saber Effect to your duplicated layer, go to Alpha Mode on the Effect and change to transparent
- 8. Under Customize Core/Core Type choose Layer Mask
