When copying text from another Word file, place the cursor where the text will be inserted and always use the “Paste Text Only” option to maintain the template formatting. Articles that do not comply with the formatting requirements of the official template will not be accepted.

Use Garamond font, 12-point, black, with single line spacing throughout the article. Use a 10-point font for block quotations, footnotes, captions, and page numbers. The first line of each paragraph should be indented by 2 cm. The text must follow the standards of the Brazilian Association of Technical Standards (ABNT) or the American Psychological Association (APA).

All notes must be formatted as **footnotes**.

When copying text from another Word file, place the cursor where the text will be inserted and always use the “Paste Text Only” option to maintain the template formatting. Articles that do not comply with the formatting requirements of the official template will not be accepted.
