# Small Groups Committee Job Description

Purpose: To provide oversight and support for the healthy functioning of and communication between Assembly small groups.

Composition: 2-4 persons + the Pastor of Faith Formation

#### Term:

- 1. Members of the committee serve 3-year terms.
  - a. Initial committee members will serve staggered terms: 2024-2025, 2024-2026, 2024-2027. Subsequent committee members will be appointed for 3-year terms.
- 2. Discerned by the congregation following the guidelines for the Leader Selection Process.
- 3. Accountable to Leadership Group.
  Pastoral team contact: Pastor of Child, Youth, and Adult Faith Formation

### Committee Responsibilities:

- 1. Organize periodic small group reps meetings (4 or more times per year)
- 2. Organize and monitor the Shuffle process
- 3. Provide greater opportunities for people to join/forms groups throughout the year
- 4. Check-in with each small group 2x a year
- 5. Develop and provide resources for SGs (e.g. discussion questions, best practices, adult faith formation, ...)
- 6. Consider events and trainings to further small group life

#### Time Involved:

 Meets about monthly from August-May, with additional meetings as needed during the small group shuffle process.

#### Qualifications:

- 1. Active participant in the congregation.
- 2. Has experience with Assembly small groups through past participation in 2 or more small groups.
- 3. Willing to work alongside and collaborate with others in overseeing Assembly small groups.
- 4. Has an understanding of and commitment to Assembly's mission and vision.
