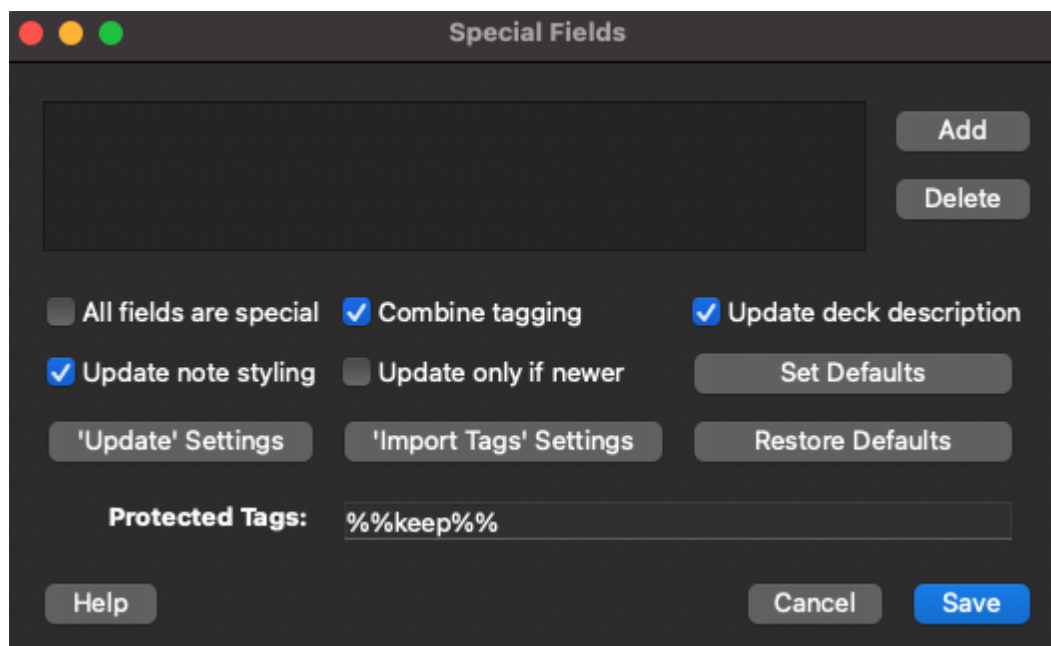
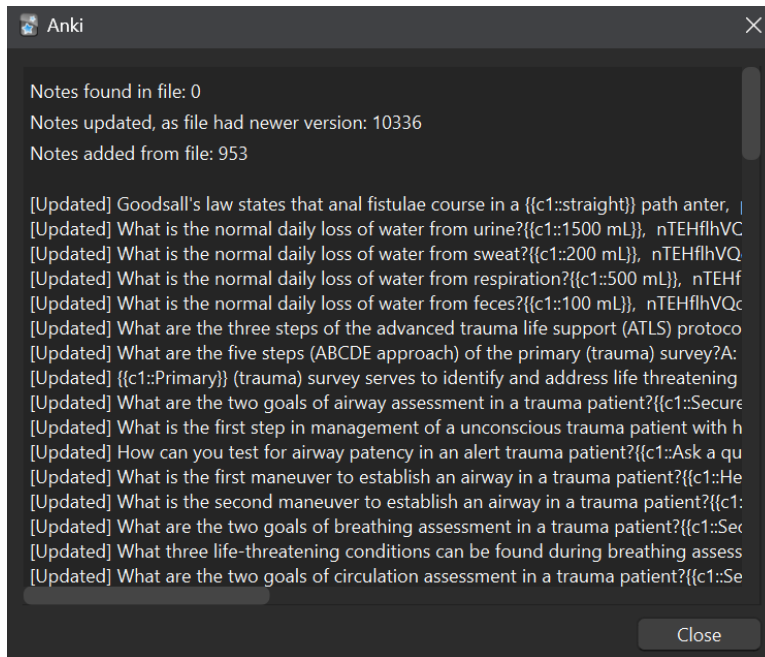


How do I get started with the OZANKI Deck?

1. Make sure you are on the [latest stable build of Anki](#) – I use version 2.1.55 (as of 25/03/23).
2. Get the [Special Fields addon](#) if you don't already have it.
3. If you don't already have the Anking deck, get the [Anking v11](#).
4. If you an older version of Anking, update it to Anking v11.
 - a. Make sure to use 'Update' Settings button in Special Fields addon.
 - b. Also protect any of the fields you want using Special Fields addon.
 - c. Lastly, move the Anking deck outside of any sub-deck structure.
 - d. Now you can go ahead and install the Anking v11.
5. Follow Steps 3 and 4 for any of the other pre-made decks you would like to have from the list below.
 - a. This is only necessary if:
 - i. You ever decide to use any of them in the future, AND
 - ii. You don't want to have 'messy' organisation of your decks and cards.
 - iii. For the vast majority of people, you can skip this step.
 - b. List of other pre-made decks (which you can find on Reddit):
 - i. Dope
 - ii. Herring Radiology
 - iii. Hoop Radiology
 - iv. The 22 "Must-See" Diagnosis
 - v. Top 3 Differentials in Radiology
6. Move the Anking deck outside of any sub-deck structure.
7. Move the OZANKI deck outside of any sub-deck structure and delete previous tags.
 - a. This step is important if you already have the OZANKI deck (i.e. Bond Students).
 - b. Look for tags such as “!BondMD” or “!Kush_MEDI_XXX” and delete them.
 - c. Delete the tags NOT the cards inside the tags – your progress on these cards will remain.
8. Open Special Fields addon and have the same boxes ticked/unticked as below.

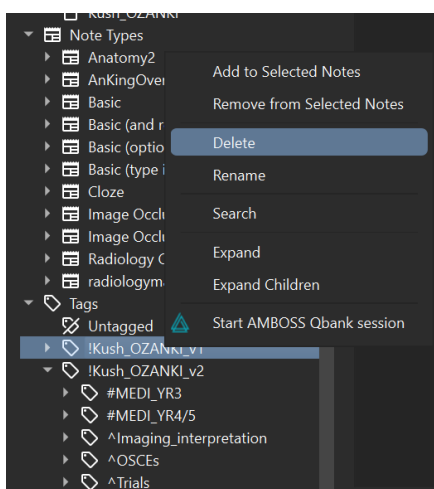


- a.
 - b. Having the “Update note styling” ticked is important if you want the eTG button and more.
 - c. Having the “Combine tagging” ticked is important if you don't want to lose any of your own tags.
 - d. Not having any protected fields is important if you want all the edits I have made to the cards to make them consistent with Australian guidelines.
 - e. Click save and close out of Special Fields tab.
9. Download the OZANKI_v2.
 10. Import the OZANKI deck (i.e. by double clicking on the file usually from your downloads folder).
 - a. Once you have imported the deck, you should get a message like the one below.

 - c. Make sure the number of notes found and added matches the file name: $10336 + 953 = \mathbf{11289}$
 - d. Also make sure that it says [Added] or [Updated] and NOT [Skipped].
 - e. If it says [Skipped], then it means that Special Fields is broken / you did not set it up right.
11. You will now have a deck called "**Kush_OZANKI**".
 - a. This will have all the new cards that you didn't already have (i.e. cards from pre-made decks such as Dope or the Imaging decks or cards that I made).
 - b. Feel free to move cards from this deck to wherever you please.
 12. Open the browser and use search command **is:new -is:suspended** to find and suspend all the new cards.
 - a. You can then unsuspend them using the **Tags** in the browser when you are ready to study them.
 13. Cross out of browser / Go to the Anki home page and delete all empty cards.
 - a. Click on Tools > Empty Cards > Tick "Keep notes with no valid cards" > Delete.
 14. Move the decks into their sub-deck organisation if you want.
 15. Open the browser and under **Tags** on the left hand side, you will find a tag called "**!Kush_OZANKI_v2**".
 - a. Use the drop-down arrows to explore the hierarchy of the tags and locate the topics you want.
 - b. And when you are ready, you can unsuspend the cards you wish to study.
 - c. Spacebar away!

NOTE: If you are updating from a previous version, those tags will still be present, feel free to right-click > delete them.
