#### I. RECONVENE FROM ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING:

A. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF VISITORS:

Brad Slagh updated the board on recent issues being discussed in Lansing: the budget is complete, the need for balancing laws, funding for 23-24 school year and an upcoming speed limit bill.

Mike O'Connor, Christina Quimby from Adult Education, and Anna Castillo from the OAISD, updated the board with a presentation on the adult ed program, who it serves, and the amazing things this program is doing for those in the community.

#### V. DISCUSSION

A. <u>Bid Approval</u> – all bids were reviewed by the finance committee on July 17th at 3:00pm.

**HVAC Bid Approvals** - This purchase is for the Woodbridge Elementary Chiller and pumps replacement. This work will take place in summer of 2024. If the

board approves this pre-order, DHE will order the equipment and store it at their secure facility until it is needed for the summer work. The finance committee recommends we move forward with the purchase.

**Maintenance Truck Replacement** - This will be the last truck purchase for the maintenance department. This will replace a 2000 4 X 4 which we use for plowing and other maintenance around the district. This truck will be purchased with the General Operating funds for vehicle replacements. The finance committee recommends we move forward with this purchase.

**Auditorium Updates** - This request will replace the projector and screen at DeWitt auditorium. We will move the current projector at DeWitt to Lokers. David Miller and Mark Washington have been working through the auditorium equipment replacements. This purchase will be completed with the 2023-24 Enhancement Millage budget. The finance committee recommends we move forward with this purchase.

**Recreation Equipment and Flooring** - After a bid process was completed, Brett would like to have the Fitness Things Equipment approved for purchase and installation. We also will need to install new flooring upstairs and downstairs to accommodate moving the weight equipment upstairs and moving the cardio programs downstairs. Fitness Things is a lower cost then the flooring consortium and comparable to the same type of flooring and protection. This quote also meets the architects requirement for safety and protection. The finance committee recommends we move forward with this purchase.

**Band Instruments -** This request is being funded with the 2021 Bond Series II. This is round 2 of instrument replacements. Lucas Keur has been working with the vendors and did a very thorough bid process to get the best price for these dollars. The finance Committee recommends we move forward with this purchase.

B. Ratification of One-Year ZEA Contract for 2023-2024 School Year - Jon Voss gave a brief overview of the changes that were made to the calendar and advised the new contract was passed by the teachers earlier in the week.
