

Create personalised learning opportunities through Google Forms

Overview/Use Case

Like adventure books where you had a choice of page to go to when you encountered a cliffhanger moment. Google forms can be used to create a digital version and provide choices for learners to take. This is achieved by utilising the sections, and send to section options in a Google form where you can direct users through to different sections of the form based on their choice in a multiple choice or drop down style question.

Activity Steps

1. Share your copy of the live form with attendees or assign it in Google Classroom.
2. Ask them to work through the form trying out the different routes.
3. Open the edit view of the form to show responses coming in.
4. Once most have responded (you may need to encourage them to give an answer if they are being too conscientious) show the edit view of the form and how to create a sheet of responses.
5. Create a sheet of responses.
6. Use [your copy of this form to demonstrate](#) how to add sections for each multiple choice option.
7. Add four sections to the form for each multiple choice answer.
 - a. Leading Digital Learning
 - b. Developing Digital Learning
 - c. Learning about Digital Learning
 - d. Discovering Digital Learning
8. Go to the multiple choice question and use the three dot icon in the bottom right corner to select "Go to section based on answer" and change the first option to go to the section you just created.
9. Add [this video](#) to the Discovering digital learning section. If you have time it is worth playing too.
10. Ensure that you show people the option at the end of each section that directs the user automatically to the next section. This needs to be changed to move users over sections they should not see. This is only relevant if you have a section that does not use the send to a section option on a question Such as the final destination sections in the adventure.
11. Show how to send the form via a link.
12. Now attendees need to make their own form with at least
 - a. One opening question that will send users to sections
 - b. 3 or 4 sections

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c. Video and images

13. If you have used classroom to share the first task get everyone to click on send and add the link to the classroom comments so other can have a go. Otherwise create a shared document to share links. HINT: check everyone makes their form viewable to anyone in settings.

Extra Tips

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Extension Task

- Awesome-table.com can be used to analyse larger amounts of data collected from a form.
- Use the explore tool in sheets to analyse the responses.
- Use Google Forms to design an adventure story which is relevant to a topic in your subject. How might students use it as a tool to further develop their understanding?
