Uniform Policy FAQs

Why does the school have a uniform policy?

The first and most important reason is equity amongst the students. The social status of the "right" clothing is put aside and allows the students to focus on community and academics. Secondly, it looks good. It is good branding and marketing for the school community. The students will look neat, professional, and ready to learn!

What does the uniform look like?

Dark blue polo shirts (short sleeve or long sleeve) and khaki pants and shorts for boys and girls, and skirts, scooters, and shorts are also options for the girls.

Are there uniform options for cold weather days?

Our vendor offers a zip-up fleece and a full zip sport-wick jacket that is approved for school wear. The fleece and jacket must have the logo on it. These can be worn on both Mass and PE days.

Where can I buy the uniforms?

Uniforms can be ordered through JoAnn's Uniforms in Colchester, Vermont. (http://joannsuniforms.com/)

Why only one vendor?

While multiple vendors can help with the cost, it makes uniform enforcement and consistency all but impossible. In order to maintain a quality and professional look, we thought it important to go with one source. It is also important to go with a local, Catholic, and supportive vendor like JoAnn's.

Is the cost different?

JoAnn's Uniforms has quoted a price consistent with Frenchtoast.com and Lands End. The cost will be about the same.

What about pants, skorts, scooters, and shorts?

These items will be available for purchase through JoAnn's Uniforms as well. Families are welcome to shop in other locations for these items. The Khaki items (Khaki Chino dress pants) should all be dress style (not cargo or casual) and neat. Only the blue polo shirt, PE "Squires" t-shirt, zip-up fleece, and sport-wick jacket will be exclusive to JoAnn's Uniforms.

What is the PE uniform?

The PE uniform is still blue shorts or sweatpants and the PE "Squires" t-shirt from JoAnn's. Yoga pants or stretch pants are not allowed to be worn. Other SFX Athletic gear is also not allowed (CYO, Softball, Baseball, Cross Country).
