To Valued RSU 4 Residents:

Over 148 residents attended the October 21, 2023 Public Budget Meeting to determine and approve the budget to be considered for approval through the Referendum Vote on November 7, 2023.

Here is a summary of the changes made at the recent Public Meeting:

- The revised budget is \$21,577,585.37.
 - This is a 1.34% increase over last year's budget.
 - o Increased Regular Instruction by \$45,473.61.
 - o Reduced System Administration by \$20,000.
 - Reduced School Administration by \$20,060.09.
 - Reduced Facilities Maintenance by \$287,617.09.
 - Total Reduction from the Original Proposed Budget is \$875,579.45.
