Session Overview

On **November 2, 2022**, the Telescope Network hosted a Connect & Share webinar session on the topic "How can we work together to best support the needs of our students?" We had **26** people attend the session from **19** different schools or departments.





What is a Connect & Share Panel Discussion?

During a Connect & Share panel webinar, participants hear from BPS colleagues about what's working in their classrooms and schools. Presenters share a 10-minute presentation about an effective practice. Participants connect with peers from across BPS, get new ideas, and earn PD hours..

Why this topic?

This session topic was identified as part of the <u>Telescope Network Spring 2022 needs assessment</u>. One of the major themes in the survey data was the want for effective teaming. Sample educator responses:

- How can general ed. educators and specialists work together for the needs of the students?
- How do we effectively plan or allocate more time in CPT to work and align lessons/curriculum?
- Educators in specific content area classrooms (Multilingual Educators, SLIFE, Science, etc) want more collaboration opportunities with each other across the district.
- How to make time for mini-lessons addressing gaps in student learning while moving grade level content forward, best practice/curriculum for ELD 1s in ELA classes
