

Leader Learning Lab Catalog: Semester 1 (September 2024 - January 2025)

The Office of Professional Learning is excited to launch Leader Learning Labs after the pilot in SY23-24. Leader Learning Labs are optional professional development (PD) opportunities for school leaders on Monday afternoons outside of the formal PD days. Modeled after Tune Up Tuesdays for teachers, these leader learning labs take place after school hours and are offered virtually or in-person.

Each session will be branded either as a "learning" session or a "lab" session. Learning sessions focus on developing leaders' understanding of new content, while lab sessions focus on developing leaders' skills and practices through hands-on, facilitated work time. This catalog will specify the format so leaders can sign up for the development that best fits their needs.

All session registrations need to take place through PowerSchool. They will be available only to principals, assistant principals, and climate managers. The stepper for registering for courses in PowerSchool is <u>HERE</u>.
