Location and Specimen Type: Anus, biopsy

Short History:

A 34-year-old male with a history of HIV infection since 2013, receiving highly active antiretroviral therapy (HAART), presented with perianal itching, pain and rash for several days. Digital rectal examination reveals multiple small vesiculopapular lesions involving the perianal skin. Under the impression of sex-transmitted disease, such as syphilis, biopsy was performed. The biopsy showed anal mucosa with ulcer and pustule formation. Suspected viral inclusion-like change is noted over dyskeratotic cells. Immunohistochemical studies of CMV, HSV, spirochete were all negative. PAS, GMS and acid-fast stain done, neither fungal element nor acid fast bacillus found.
