Furthermore, consider that current members are all tenured, perhaps to ensure they have experience, but also possibly to protect members that might propose controversial policies.
- 6. Clarify definitions of regular faculty, lecturer faculty, etc., and those rights and responsibilities, and determine if privileges are blocked by language in the constitution or bylaws that is out of date or inconsistent with other CSUs.
- 7. Lecturers are not assigned to do service to the university. But since many Lecturers do such service, can you propose a policy for when and how such service should be compensated?
- 8. Lecturer role in department decisions seems to vary across departments. Should policy standardize policy regarding attendance and voting in department decisions?
