Essay layout

Your essay should include the following sections:

| Section heading | What to include |

| Introduction | Give your reader a clear idea of what your essay will cover |
| Background and context | Describe the importance of the chosen theme, the magnitude of the problem, and how is it relevant to the Indonesian context |
| Analysis and potential solutions | Examine existing public health programmes, describe the strength and limitations of the existing problem in comparison to other new/existing potential solutions being implemented somewhere else |
| Enablers and barriers to the proposed solutions | Critically evaluate and highlight factors that may enable or pose a barrier to the implementation of the proposed solutions |
| Conclusion and future recommendations | Draw conclusions and formulate a set of recommendations for public health policy and future research |
| References (not included in word count) | Cite all of your sources using the <u>Vancouver referencing style</u> |

Presentation requirements

- Use a minimum of 12 point font, with double spacing and at least 2cm page margins
- Include a statement of word count
- Submit your report as a Microsoft word

Sources and referencing

You are expected to cite from a range of sources, which may include:

- Government reports and publications, non-government reports, and other similar official materials
- Peer-reviewed scientific literature that you have sourced for yourself through literature and database searches (e.g. scientific journal articles, papers and books)

You must cite all of your sources using the Vancouver referencing style.

A maximum of one Table and one panel of figures that are directly relevant to your text may be included (these will be excluded from the word counts). All tables or figures should be accompanied by a caption describing its content and citing its source.
