Application usage: The first time you open up any apps, it may ask you if you want to allow notifications. Click “Don’t Allow” if it asks you if you would like the app to send you notifications. If you hit “allow”, you may occasionally get notifications on your iPad which can add clutter to your device.

Sight Word Phonics Flash Cards: Practice speaking in English, practice new vocabulary, and connect English words to pictures of the words the users are learning

- Allows people using the iPad (the users) to practice their English pronunciations
- Helps them understand different English words

To Open - touch: Sight Words Phonics Flash Cards App.

Click: “Start” button.

Click: “Part A” for simple words

Click: “Part B” for more complex words.

A word will appear on the screen with an attached icon.

Click on the word to hear its pronunciation. Practice the pronunciation.

When you feel confident with the pronunciation, **click** the *right arrow* for a new word and practice the pronunciation.

1. To hear the word out loud, touch the word. Be sure the volume is loud.
2. To move to the next word, touch the arrow on the right. To move back to the last word, touch the arrow on the left.
3. To return to the home menu, touch the house icon.

When complete, hit the “home” button (the iPad’s belly button).

ShowMe:

- Allows you to draw, and do simple lessons for your students.
- Allows you to create video lessons that can be used by your students.
- These lessons can be drawing lessons, math problems, and simple English phonics lessons.

To open: ShowMe, tap the app and open up to the first screen - On the top menu

Click: On the **red “create” button** in the top right corner of the screen

Drawing tools!

Adjust your brush size,

- **Click** on a color and the size you choose. Try drawing waves, mountains, and trees!

Add a color:

- **Click** the “+” button on the top right side. Try things like signing your name, writing words (in English or Nepali) or write out math problems.

Erase your work at any time:

- **Click** the eraser button on the top left of the screen.
- The **eraser button** can be found **between the Aa button** and the **add photo button**.
- If you make a **mistake**, **click the back button**, which is in the top center and is an arrow to the left.

To record a lesson,

- **Click** the center “record” button: You can record a simple lesson in drawing, math, or simple English phonics lessons.
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- **Click** the “record” button, a timer will appear at the bottom of the iPad - and everything you draw and say during this time will be recorded.
- To finished, **click** “done.”
 - If you do not like the video, **click** “discard”.
 - If you liked it, click “**save and upload Showme video**”.
 - To enable students to find your lesson, Label “TriKa lesson” with the subject and today’s date attached - for example “TriKa lesson - English - 7/10/19”.
 - Click “Done.”
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Access lessons from other teachers around the world.

- When POWER IS ON,
- Click “explore” and then click “mathematics.”
- Hundreds of math lessons from around the world will become available to you.

iBooks

Click the iBooks icon on the home screen.

- This will bring up all of the digital books in the library.
- To see a book, click on the cover
- Book will load
- Use the book in class

Facetime

- Click the Contacts button on the bottom dock of your iPad.
- You will see four contacts you can facetime.
- To try to facetime someone, click on “Ben Honeycutt”
- This will facetime another iPad at any time.
- To try, click “FaceTime Ben”
