- One of the rules is that if someone commits academic dishonesty it is reported to their colleges
- [Speaker] has dealt with a number of issues this year
 - Doesn't feel like the process is diminishing

- Most students usually only have one issue so they are able to go through restorative practice
- Most students usually opt to go through this practice, avoiding the consequences including the report to colleges
- A few students have had more than one issue of academic dishonesty so they do not end up having the option of going through restorative practice
- These students usually go through the practice anyway to make sure that the issue is cleared up
- [Speaker's] concerns are alleviated now that they know about the restorative practice option
