 who desire to advance in higher education or skills OR who are currently seeking personal advancement through
 higher education, trade school, or by joining the military.
- The applicant must be, be the child, stepchild, grandchild, step-grandchild, adoptive child, or adoptive stepchild of a veteran of the United States of America.
- Scholarships will be awarded only to students who desire to advance in their education or trade while attending an accredited institution of higher education and/ or vocational/ technical schools and/ or the military.
- All scholarship funds will be released to the recipient's school of choice OR directly to the recipient.
- The purpose of this Scholarship Program is to emphasize the image of the youth of America, to safeguard and transmit to posterity, the principles of justice, freedom, and democracy while fostering and perpetuating a one hundred percent Americanism.
- Recipients are only eligible to receive this scholarship once, repeat applications will not be accepted.
